As you may know, recently enacted bipartisan legislation rescinds \$150 million from SSBCI. Importantly, no jurisdiction that has been approved or applied for funds will see a reduction in that allocation. In particular, funding in the following categories will not be reduced as a result of this legislation:

- Capital Program allocations for all approved jurisdictions.
- Capital Program allocations for jurisdictions (states, territories, D.C., and Tribal governments)
  currently under review: Funds allocated to states, territories, DC, and Tribal governments for
  capital allocations for which Treasury has received a timely and complete
  application. (Allocations to states, territory, and DC may be found <a href="here">here</a>. Allocations to Tribal
  governments remain the same as in the application portal.)
- Formula Technical Assistance (TA) Grant Program allocations for states, territories, and D.C. currently under review: Funds allocated to states, territories, and DC under the TA Grant Program for which Treasury has received an application. (Allocations to states, territories, and DC may be found here.)
- Formula TA Grant Program allocations for Tribal governments: Funds allocated to Tribal governments under the TA Grant Program for which applications are due July 28, 2023. (Allocations to Tribal governments remain the same as in the application portal.)
- Incentive allocation: Funds set aside for the capital program incentive allocation.
