CDFA Releases Redevelopment Financing Recommendations for Bessemer Historical Society dba Steelworks Center of the West

Columbus, OH – The Council of Development Finance Agencies (CDFA) is excited to release the Roadmap to Redevelopment report prepared for the Bessemer Historical Society dba Steelworks Center of the West in Pueblo, Colorado.

CDFA staff and technical assistance providers traveled to Pueblo, Colorado to provide recommendations for financing the cleanup and \$12M renovation of the former Colorado Fuel and Iron Company (CF&I) administrative building into a multi-use space for a museum expansion. The new Steelworks Center will highlight the history of CF&I and the industrialization of the West with new exhibits, education rooms, and offices. The team toured the project site and held meetings with several local stakeholders.

"The Steelworks Center has the vision and dedication to drive this unique project to completion; the financing recommendations we've presented provide actionable next steps which we are optimistic will position them very well for a variety of financing sources," said Emily Moser, Program Manager for CDFA's Brownfields Technical Assistance Program.
