We are seeking an experienced individual with superb management and communication skills, who can operate in a matrixed environment and with competing priorities. The individual will be a collaborator who can influence and drive others to action without direct authority. They will need to be driven by purpose and have a deep commitment to public service and social impact.

- Create and implement data governance and definition principles to manage data as an asset.

- Identify, design, and deploy opportunities to leverage data to increase operational excellence.
- Own data visualization, storytelling, and reporting across the organization to key stakeholders.
