Federal Brownfield Incentives

U.S. EPA

- Site Assessment (City \$200,000 available)
- Cleanup Grants
- Revolving Loan Fund (County \$2 million available)

<u>HUD</u>

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- Brownfield Economic Development Initiative (BEDI) Grants
- Section 108 loans



Michigan Brownfield Incentives

MDEQ site assessment grants (City -\$300,000 available)

MDEQ site cleanup grants and loans

 Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Abatement



What about Brownfield Redevelopment Authorities?

Brownfield Tax Increment Financing (TIF)

Brownfield bonds

Single Business Tax Credit



Genesee County Land Bank Brownfield Funds

- Brownfield tax increment financing (\$10.2 million)
- EPA site assessment grants (\$600,000)
- EPA Cleanup Grant (\$200,000)
- EPA Revolving Loan Fund (\$2 million)
- MDEQ assessment and cleanup grants/loans (\$540,000)

Total of \$13.54 million



How to Access Brownfield Tools

2 types of brownfield project examples:

- 1. Assessment and remediation to redevelop tax foreclosed brownfield property
- 2. Eliminating blight using a Brownfield Bond revenue reimbursed with brownfield TIRs


Land Bank Brownfield Plan

Eliminate blight on tax foreclosed properties






Land Bank Properties in the City of Flint

Land Bank Brownfield Plan

- Issued \$5,000,000 brownfield bond to front costs of demolition and other activities
- Projected new value of \$18 million on the tax roll
- Capture taxes from properties returned to the tax roll to repay bond







RESULTS

Demolished 449 blighted structures



- Cleared 107 land titles for title insurance
- Cleared 241 vacant lots of debris



2007 Plan Amendment

- 800 additional properties
- Refinance the bond to leverage \$7.37 million.

Activities:

- Eliminate blight and cleanup dumping
- Abate lead and asbestos in renovated houses in Flint
- Clear title
- Complete infrastructure improvements
- Support the redevelopment of the former Berridge and Durant hotels



PROJECTS - Durant Hotel

109 affordable and market rate apartment units and conference/ meeting space.

Total investment over \$21 million.





PROJECTS – BERRIDGE PLACE

20 market rate and affordable housing units and commercial space



Total proposed investment - \$5.3 million
