Mr. Busker earned a Bachelor of Science in Recreation, Park & Tourism Administration from Western Illinois University (2015), a Master of Public Affairs (MPA) from the Robert M. La Follette School of Public Affairs at the University of Wisconsin–Madison (2021), and a Master of Science in Urban and Regional Planning from the University of Wisconsin–Madison (2021).

Outside of work, he can be found exploring the Houston region's diverse and award-winning food scene, playing board games and video games with his wife and friends, roaming the Texas Renaissance Festival, and attending his stepson's sporting events. He resides with his wife, stepson, six cats, and two dogs in the fast-growing unincorporated area between Houston and Katy, Texas.
