



Inclusion of Bond Finance Title in the Infrastructure Bill

- Tax-exempt bonds are the most impactful infrastructure finance tool
- A bonds section will open the door for the inclusion of many necessary bond-related provisions

Modernizing Agricultural and Manufacturing Bonds Act (MAMBA)

- Expand the capacity and usability of IDBs and Aggie bonds
- Expand access to capital for small manufacturers and agricultural producers

New Exempt Facility Bond Category for Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations

- Compliment existing federal programs
- Accelerate nationwide rollout and expansion of green infrastructure

Reinstating Tax-Exempt Advance Refunding Bonds

- Increase debt capacity and make more capital available for infrastructure projects
- Serve as a low-cost option for refinancing debt
