## **MAJOR VICTORY**

#### for the development finance industry

- ► Reauthorization of SSBCI first introduced in March 2020 as part of CDFA's Comprehensive COVID-19 Recovery Strategy
- Briefed the Biden-Harris transition team about the importance of SSBCI
- ▶ Introduced again in January 2021
- ► Included in the American Rescue Plan
- ▶ President Biden expected to sign into law on March 12, 2021



## **HISTORY OF SSBCI**

- ▶ \$1.5 Billion program introduced in 2010
- ► Leveraged 8:1 in private investment
- ► Supported 16,900 small businesses, resulting in the creation or retention of 190,000 jobs
- ► CDFA built the SSBCI Coalition, held several meetings and webinars for states, tracked best practices, made recommendations to Treasury on improvements, and spearheaded all advocacy efforts



#### WHAT'S IN SSBCI 2.0?

- ▶ \$10 Billion for the reauthorization of SSBCI
- ▶ Program runs through September 30, 2030
- Approximately \$5 Billion available to states to be distributed by formula based on 2020 unemployment numbers
- ▶ 10:1 leverage ratio
- ► Must have "CDFI and MDI Participation Plan"; must have "Pandemic Response Plan"

## WHAT'S IN SSBCI 2.0?

- ► Allocations for key activities:
  - ▶ \$1.5B for socially and economically disadvantaged businesses
  - ► \$1B incentive program to encourage investment in socially and economically disadvantaged businesses
  - ▶ \$500M for tribal governments
  - ▶ \$500M for micro businesses
  - ▶ \$500M for technical assistance to states for legal, accounting, and financial advisory services



## REACTIONS FROM STATES

- Encouraging leadership to support SSBCI
- Evaluating existing SSBCI programs; evaluating the need for new programs
- ► Identifying proactive strategies for engaging CDFIs and MDIs
- Preparing for application round
- ► Awaiting guidance from Treasury
