

Create 75,000 Jobs over 5 years





Increase the average wage of total jobs










ACA Results, by Destination City FY2014






ACA FY2013 Results and Five-Year Impact




Business Attraction and Expansion strategies

 - Develop relationships with key personnel at the top 200 companies in Arizona




All ACA Pipeline by Industry

Business Attraction Pipeline by Preferred City/Town, YTD Q4-2014






Business Attraction Pipeline by Industry






Business Attraction Pipeline by Origin

Pipeline Projects (BA) Business Attraction Pipeline by Geographic Segment, YTD Q1-2015


