Mr. Guy also worked with a non-profit climate action group, as well as various political entities involved in grassroots campaign organizing. Mr. Guy is a graduate of The Ohio State University. He is the proud holder of a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science, with Minors in City and Regional Planning and International Relations.
